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
# What is the Mission of IES?

- Develop measures of academic achievement and progress








### STEPS TO APPLYING FOR IES GRANTS

- 1. Identify a current funding opportunity that matches your research interests and identify the relevant Letter of Intent and application deadlines.
- 2. View a <u>funding opportunities webinar</u> to learn more about the application process and choosing an appropriate funding opportunity and refer to our digital technical assistance page for additional resources.
- 3. Download the Application Submission Guide, as well as the appropriate Request for Applications and application package (Search for CFDA 84.305 or CFDA 84.324).
- Submit your <u>Letter of Intent</u> (optional but strongly encouraged).
- Register (or update) your organization on <u>Grants.gov</u> and <u>SAM.gov</u>.
- Submit your application to <u>Grants.gov</u> before the application <u>deadline</u>.








### NCER 305A – Numbers of Applications Reviewed and Funded FY2008-FY2020
